



What to bring



Clayoquot Wilderness Lodge is located in Canada's rugged, remote Pacific Northwest. It's wise to arrive prepared for the elements and we recommend packing comfortable, functional clothing including wet weather gear. Average daily temperatures during the summer range from 10-18°C (68-72°F) with overnight lows between 10-15°C (52-62°F). Guest tents are heated by cosy cast iron stoves and hearth fires in the guest lounging areas are always stoked.

Packing list

- Waterproof hiking shoes or hiking boots
- Running shoes, sandals (optional)
- Bathing suit for hot tubs, saunas and swimming at Penny Falls
- Athletic and/or yoga wear (optional)
- Base layer tops and bottoms - the lightweight sort for skiing is perfect
- Warm fleece layers (eg: vest, sweater, jacket)
- Gore-Tex or other rain and windproof jacket
- Trekking/outdoor pants and shorts
- Jeans or long pants for horseback riding
- Moisture-wicking sports shirts - long and short sleeve
- Camera, batteries, chargers
- Reusable water bottle (we have stainless steel bottles available too)
- Sunglasses, hats, croakies
- Toiletries
- Medications, Ibuprofen and allergy relief

- Rain pants, jackets, boots and umbrellas
- Toques (beanies) and gloves
- Horseback riding boots and helmets
- Floater suits for wildlife viewing, life jackets, wetsuits for canyoning and stand up paddle boarding
- Fishing gear and waders
